HOW TO PREPARE FOR A PROGRESS REVIEW BOARD

A progress review (often called a Board of Review) is a meeting between you and some of the troop leaders where they check to be certain that you meet all of the requirements for your progress award.

What should I wear and bring?

- Wear your full Class A uniform (with merit badge & OA sashes if you have them)
- Bring your Scout Handbook
- Bring your record of service hours required

What types of questions might be asked?

- Scout Spirit
 - o Be able to repeat the Scout Oath, Law, Motto, Slogan and Outdoor Code and understand what each means
 - o You may be asked how you live out these Scouting values in your daily life
 - o You may be asked "Tell how you have done your Duty to God"
- Participation
 - o The review members will review your attendance records (meetings and trips) with you, so be prepared to explain any large gaps or poor attendance times.
- Requirements
 - O The review board is responsible to check all requirements for the reviewed rank. You should check with your instructors to ensure all requirements are complete before going to the review board.
